Lesson 3: God's Inherent and Relational Attributes



- God's inherent attributes الصفات الذاتية are the attributes we can understand just by studying God, without looking at His relation to anything
- Theologians have listed the inherent attributes of God.
- Last week we spoke about God's Oneness.

• 2. Knowledge العلم

"Know: that God knows everything" Quran 2:231

- Defining knowledge: the fact or condition of knowing something with familiarity gained through experience or association
- Knowledge is of two types:
 - العلم الحصولي Acquired knowledge
 - العلم الحضوري Presential knowledge

"The number of droplets of water, or of stars in the sky, or of gusts of wind in the air are not unknown to Him, and neither is the crawling of ants on rocks, nor the settling place of tiny ants in the darkness of the night. He knows the spots where leaves fall and the subtle movement of the pupils of the eyes."- Imam Ali

لَم يَزَلْ عالمًا بما يَكُونُ، فعِلمُهُ بِهِ قَبلَ كُونِهِ كعِلمِه بِهِ بَعدَ كُونِهِ

"He always knows what is to be, such that His knowledge of it before its coming into being is the same as His knowledge after its coming into being." – Imam al-Baqir

• 3. Power القدرة

"God has power over all things" Quran 2:259

الإِمامُ عليُّ عليه السلام - لمَّا قيل لَهُ: هل يِقدرُ ربُّك علي أن يدخل الدنيا في بيضة له : إنَّ اللَّهَ تَبارَكَ وتَعالى لا يُنسَبُ إلَى العجز ، والّذي سألتني لا يكونُ سألتني لا يكونُ

Imam Ali was once asked, 'Can your Lord fit the world into an egg?' to which he replied, 'Verily Allah, Mighty and Exalted, cannot be attributed with incapacity, but that which you are asking cannot ever be.'

- God has power over all "things"
- God does not have power over that which is inherently impossible, not because of any limitation in His power, but because the proposition has no reality.

الحياة 4. Life

"Put your trust in the Living who does not die"
 Quran 25:58

"God is Omnipresent without any external source of life ... rather He lives through Himself [is Self-existent]."- Imam al-Kadhim

- God is Living, but not in the biological sense
- He did not acquire life from another being, nor is His life followed by death.
- He is the giver of all Life

 We cannot know more about his essence than these basic inherent attributes

'Ponder over the creation of God, but do not ponder about God Himself [His essence] lest you be ruined."- The Holy Prophet (saw)

- We assign these attributes to Him minus any aspect of imperfection they may connote:
 - since he has no imperfection
 - nothing is like him

• God's relational attributes الصفات الفعلية are the attributes we can understand only after analyzing God's relation to His creatures. For instance, He is not a "creator" until He has made something, though He does have the knowledge and power to create before He creates.

- Divine Policies (God's sunnahs)-policies by which God governs His dealings with His creatures
- Let us first examine these Divine policies as they apply to the temporal world (dunya)

- Overview of policies
 - God creates,
 - God sustains,
 - God guides,
 - God destroys all His creatures in the temporal world

- Policies toward inanimate creatures
 - He creates them

قَالَ رَبُّنَا الَّذِي أَعْطَى كُلُّ شَيْءٍ خَلْقَهُ ثُمَّ هَدَى

"He gives everything its existence and then guides

it." Quran 20:50

He sustains them

"God protects the heavens and the earth from destruction. If they were set to be destroyed, no one could hold back their destruction except him." Quran 35:41

He guides them to fulfill their purpose

"He gives everything its existence and then guides it." Quran 20:50

- What is the major purpose of inanimate creatures?
 - To exalt God

"The seven heavens, the earth, and whoever resides therein exalt him. Every single thing exalts God and praises him as he deserves, however, you do not comprehend their exaltation." Quran 17:44

- What is the major purpose of inanimate creatures?
 - to serve humanity

"And he subjugated ships for you so that they sail at sea by his command, and he subjugated the rivers for you. He subjugated the sun and the moon for you, constant in their courses, and he subjugated for you the night and the day." Quran 14:32-33

He destroys them

[Remember] when the sun will be crumpled, when the stars will go dim, and the mountains will be made to move... Quran 81:1-3

- Policies toward irrational creatures (like plants and animals)
 - He creates them

He sustains them

"Upon God is the sustenance of every animal on earth." Quran 11:6

He guides them

"Your Lord communicated to the honeybee saying, "Make your homes in the mountains, trees, and structures they have erected.

Quran16:68

He destroys them

"Everything shall perish except for Him." Quran 28:88

- Divine policies towards rational beings (angels, jinn, and humans)
 - He created us
 - As a species when He created Adam

"He began the creation of humankind from clay." Quran 32:7

يَا أَيُّهَا النَّاسُ اتَّقُواْ رَبَّكُمُ الَّذي خَلَقَكُم مِّنِ نَّفْسٍ وَاحِدَة وَالْحَدَة وَخَلَقَ مِنْهَا زَوْجَهَا وَبَثَّ مِنْهُمَا رِجَالًا كَثِيرًا وَنِسَاءً

"O People! Fear your Lord who created you [as a species] from one being and created, from that being, a mate for him and spread forth, from those two beings, many men and women" Quran 4:1

Individually through reproduction

Then we made him into a drop of [seminal] fluid [lodged] in a secure place. Then we made the drop of fluid into a clinging mass. Then we made the clinging mass into a fleshy tissue. Then we made the fleshy tissue into bones. Then we clothed the bones in flesh. Then we made him into another creature. So exalted is God, the best of creators!" Quran 23:12-14

- He sustains us
 - He provides for all of our needs
 - Sustenance

"God is the one who provides sustenance for whom e wishes and withholds [from whom he wishes]." Quran 13:26

"the one who feeds me and gives me drink." Quran 26:79

-Health

"When I fall sick, He is the one who cures me." Quran 26:80

- Shelter

"It is God who has made your homes as a place of rest for you." Quran 16:80

Clothing

"O Children of Adam! We have sent down for you clothes to cover your nakedness and for adornment..." Quran 7:26

A spouse

"Among his signs is that he has created mates for you from your own kind, so that you may find tranquility in them." Quran 30:21

Children

"God made mates for you from your own kind and made for you, from your mates, children and grandchildren.." Quran 16:72

Sleep

"Did we not make sleep for you to rest?"

- Mechanism of sustenance: How does God determine how to apportion sustenance?
 - He provides according to need

وَلَوْ بَسَطَ اللَّهُ الرِّزْقَ لِعِبَادِهِ لَبَغَوْا فِي الأَرْضِ وَلَكِن يُنَزِّلُ بِقَدَرٍ مَّا يَشَاء

"Were God to give provision for his servants freely, they would wreak havoc on earth. Rather, he sends down in precise measure whatever he wishes." Quran 42:27

- He guarantees sustenance
 - Imam Ali says: "For everything that lives, there is sustenance"
 - Imam Ali says: "His dependents are his creatures. He has guaranteed their sustenance and apportioned it.

- His guarantee is contingent upon certain things:
 - that we seek our sustenance. Imam 'Alī says, "Seek your sustenance, for it is guaranteed for the seeker"
 - that we do our duty whatever that may be. Imām al-'Askarī says, "Let [the pursuit of] sustenance, which is guaranteed, not distract you from [fulfilling] an act that is incumbent upon you"

- Why are some people given less than they need, less than they want, or more than they know what to do with?
 - If someone gets less than they need, it is either because they are not fulfilling the prerequisites or someone else is blocking their sustenance from reaching them. The oppressor will be punished, and the oppressed will be compensated.

 If someone has less than they want, or more than they know what to do with, it is either a trial, a punishment, or what is in their best interest

- How can I change what is apportioned to me?
 - some of God's decrees are contingent on our choices
 - depending on my choices, I could change my sustenance, my lifespan, my health, etc.
 - these changes in God's decree are called badā'

- He guides us to the truth
 - 1. by means of the intellect
 - Imam al-Kadhim: "O Hishām! God has two pieces of evidence against people: [one is] manifest and [the other is] hidden. That which is manifest is his messengers, prophets, and imams. That which is hidden is the [people's] intellect

2. by means of prophets

• We sent messengers as bearers of glad-tidings and as warners so that people would not have any proof against God. (4:165)

 3. by creating circumstances conducive to acceptance of the truth

We sent [messengers] to people before you, and then we seized them with hardship in hopes that they would become humble. (6:42)

 4. by reacting to our choice to heed guidance or reject it. God reinforces us on whichever path we choose

If anyone wants this temporal life, We hasten to him therein what We please for whomever We please, then we consign him to hell; he shall enter it despised, driven away.

And if anyone wants the hereafter and strives for it as he ought to strive and he is a believer their striving shall be accepted.

Each group do We aid: these as well as those out of the bounty of your Lord. For the bounty of your Lord is not limited. (17:18-20)

He takes our life

"every soul shall taste death" 29:57
