The Infallibility of Angels

The Ranks of Angels

• 1. Bearers of messages:

"Praise is for God who created the skies and the earth, who installed the angels as messengers with wings in twos, threes, and fours. He increases His creation as He wills..." Quran 35:1

- "the angels" in the plural implies "all angels".
- "messengers" are not limited to the bearers of revelation; the Quran refers to angels with other functions as "messengers" also.

"...when death comes to one of you, Our messengers take him, and they do not fail [in their duties]." Quran 6:61

"Indeed, our messengers record their trickery." Quran 10:21

2. Bearers of the Divine Throne

"Those [angels] who carry the Throne and those around it exalt [Allah] with praise of their Lord..." Quran 40:7

"And you will see the angels surrounding the Throne, exalting [Allah] with praise of their Lord..." Quran 39:75

• 3. Governing affairs of creation:

"and by the manager of affairs." Quran 79:5

• In supplication 3 of Sahifa al-Sajjadiyah, Imam al-Sajjad describes the functions of some of these angels.

"... the keepers of the rain, the drivers of the clouds, him at whose driving's sound is heard the rolling of thunder, and when the reverberating clouds swim before his driving, bolts of lightning flash; the escorts of snow and hail, the descenders with the drops of rain when they fall,...

• 4. Seeking forgiveness for the believers:

"Those [angels] who carry the Throne and those around it exalt [Allah] with praise of their Lord and believe in Him and ask forgiveness for those who have believed, [saying], "Our Lord, You have encompassed all things in mercy and knowledge, so forgive those who have repented and followed Your way and protect them from the punishment of Hellfire." Quran 40:7

• 5. Glorifying God

"They glorify [Him] night and day and do not tire." Quran 21:20

• 6. Intercession:

"...and they do not intercede except on behalf of one whom He approves." Quran 21:28

• 7. Invoking God's damnation:

"Indeed, those who disbelieve and die while they are disbelievers - upon them will be the damnation of God and of the angels and the people, all together." Quran 2:161

• 8. Comforting believers on their deathbeds:

"Indeed, those who have said, "Our Lord is God" and then remained on a right course - the angels will descend upon them, [saying], "Do not fear and do not grieve but receive good tidings of Paradise, which you were promised." Quran 41:30

• 9. Recording deeds:

"And indeed, [appointed] over you are recorders, who are noble scribes." Quran 82:10-11

• 10. Salutations upon the Prophet (s):

إِنَّ اللَّهَ وَمَلَائِكَتَهُ يُصَلُّونَ عَلَى النَّبِيِّ يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا صَلُّوا عَلَيْهِ وَسَلِّمُوا تَسْلِيمًا

"God and his angels send their prayers to the Prophet. O you who believe! Pray for him and salute him." Quran 33:56

• 11. Receiving the souls at death:

"...when death comes to one of you, Our messengers take him, and they do not fail [in their duties]." Quran 6:61

• 12. Guarding against misfortune and death

"And He is the Supreme, above His servants, and He sends keepers over you..." Quran 6:61

• 13. Supporting the believers in war:

"Recall when you were seeking your Lord's help, and he answered your prayer saying, "I shall aid you with a thousand angels in ranks." Quran 8:9
