

SUMMARY of Session THREE

- 1. The supplication provides the believer with the ability to develop their spiritual connection to Allah and at the same time, provides them with the personal stimulus, through **reading**, **reflecting** and **resolving** to **revert** their lives to be what the One they are calling upon is looking for.
- 2. "Making a supplication" does not mean that we step aside and let Allah & do everything but rather, **ALONG SIDE** our efforts of ensuring that we have done our best and used all available means to attain what we desire.
- 3. The supplications taught by the Ahl al-Bayt are meant to get us to think about what matters most in life and what we need to strive to attain through His help and working hard.

to the Course

"The human being stands between two extremes of either being the lowest of the low descending lower than the wild animals or elevating themselves to the zenith of perfection in which they surpass even the greatest of angels. The journey between these extremes takes place under the shadow of purification (tazkiyah) and ethics (akhlaq) - an obligation which all Muslims must pursue."

to the Course

"The Islamic tradition has tens of sciences which a believer tries to master, however all other branches of knowledge a Muslim seeks will obstruct their path towards spiritual insight and reaching Allah # if they are not carried out after having first purified and taken firm control of the soul. The theory of how this is carried out is taught in the Science of Ethics ('Ilm al-Akhlaq)."

INTRODUCTION to the Course

"As akhlaq is the active practice of the virtues, morality and manners which Islam has laid down through the Quran and the life of Prophet Muhammad , the believer needs to have an excellent understanding of this discipline."

GREATER than the ANGELS

When 'Abdullah ibn Sinan asked Imam al-Sadiq :: "Is the human better or the angels?" The Imam replied: "The Commander of the Faithful said, 'Allah, the Exalted, gave the angels intellect without **desire**; He gave the animals **desire** without **intellect**, and He gave **both** to the offspring of Adam. So, a person whose intellect prevails over his desire is better than the angels; while a person whose desire prevails over his intellect is worse that the beasts." (Bihar al-Anwar, Vol. 60, Pg. 299, Trad. 5)


A REVIEW OF PASSAGES OF THE SUPPLICATION MAKĀRIM AL-AKHLĀQ

INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT

"The greatest manual of supplications and guide to self-building and the most important legacy of the Ahl al-Bayt is the Saheefa. This book is not only a means of communication to Allāh — it more than that. It is a means of communicating with the soul and striving to learn and implement the teachings of the Quran in our lives."

• AI-SAHIFA AL-SAJJADIYYA is a book containing Imam al-Sajjad's 54 supplications. After the Qur'an and Nahj al-balagha, this book has an important position among the Shi'a and is known as Zabur Al Muhammad (the Psalms of the Family of Muhammad) and Injil Ahl al-Bayt (the Gospel of the Household of the Prophet).

Although this book is in the form of supplications, it contains countless Islamic teachings mentioned within the form of a supplication. In it, we ask Allāh for goodness, realizing that we must work at attaining it by learning what we need to acquire.

Subjects such as: Theology, Angels, Prophethood, status of Prophet Muhammad and the Ahl al-Bayt , Divinely-appointed leadership, Moral Virtues and Vices, Honoring the Days of Eid, Social and Economic Issues, Historical Points, Different Blessings of Allah, Manners of Asking Allāh for the Best, How to Deal with Loans and Debts, and much more are all covered.

Out of the list of supplications taught by the 4th Imam, the most famous and detailed supplication which forms a blueprint for life from al-Sahifa al-Sajjadiyya is supplication known as Du'a #20 - **Makarim al-Akhlaq**.

STATUS of the SAHEEFAH

In *Manāqib Āl Abī Tālib*, Ibn Shahrāshūb (b. 488/1095 - d. 588/1192) says, "Once, sitting with one of the top scholars in literature, a discussion surrounding the eloquence of *al-Sahifa al-Sajjadiyya* came up. He said, 'I can write a similar one for you too!' Then he took the pen and dropped his head thinking [and became speechless] and passed away in that state."

STATUS of the SAHEEFAH

In 1934, the now late Ayatullah Mar'ashi Najafi sent a copy of *al-Sahifa al-Sajjadiyya* to Shaykh al-Tantawi, the Mufti of Egypt, a renowned Sunni scholar and the author of *Tafsir al-Tantawi*. He praised the book saying:

وإني كلّما تأملتها رأيتها فوق كلام المخلوق، ودون كلام الخالق

"Whenever I reflect on it I see it as speech higher than the words of the creations, and lower than the Words of the Creator."






Islam believes in the elevation of the human being, that a human is a great and dignified creation, far above the animal world. One of the signs of this dignity is the possession of noble and magnanimous qualities. In order to achieve this behavioral excellence, the human needs to overcome his base and selfish attributes and cultivate noble qualities.



In this dū'ā' the fourth Imam specifies these qualities and shows how we can try to inculcate them in ourselves. Taken as a lesson in Islamic ethics and morality (akhlāq), the dūʿāʾ is a wonderful program for those who wish to excel in good manners...



الإمامُ علي (عَلَيه السَّلامُ) : إنَّ نَفْسَكَ مَطيَّتُكَ إِنْ أَجْهَدْ تَهَا قَتَلْتَهَا وَ إِنْ رَفَقْتَ بِهَا أَبْقَيْتَهَا Imam 'Alī said, "Verily your soul is your riding mount, if you make it carry more than it can bear, you will kill it; and if you treat it with kindness, you will save it."

وَلا تَرْفَعْنِي فِي النَّاسِ دَرَجَةً إِلا حَطَطْتَنِي عِندَ نَفْسِي مِثْلَهَا

"Raise me not a single degree before the people without lowering me its like in myself.

وَلا تُحْدِثْ لِي عِزّاً ظَاهِراً إِلاَّ أَحْدَثْتَ لِي ذِلَّةً بَاطِنَةً عِندَ نَفْسِي بِقَدَرِهَا

And bring about no outward exaltation for me without an inward abasement in myself to the same measure!"

وَعَبَدْنِي لَكَ وَلا تُفْسِدْ عِبِادَتِي بِالعُجْبِ

"Make me worship You and corrupt not my worship with self-admiration!

وَأُجْرِ لِلنَّاسِ عَلَى يَدَيُّ الْخَيْرَ وَلا تَمْحَقْهُ بِالْمَنِّ

Let good flow out from my hands upon the people and efface it not by my making them feel obliged!"

for then I would deserve Your abandonment, Your withholding, and Your turning away..."


CONCLUSION of MAKARIM AL-AKHLAQ
